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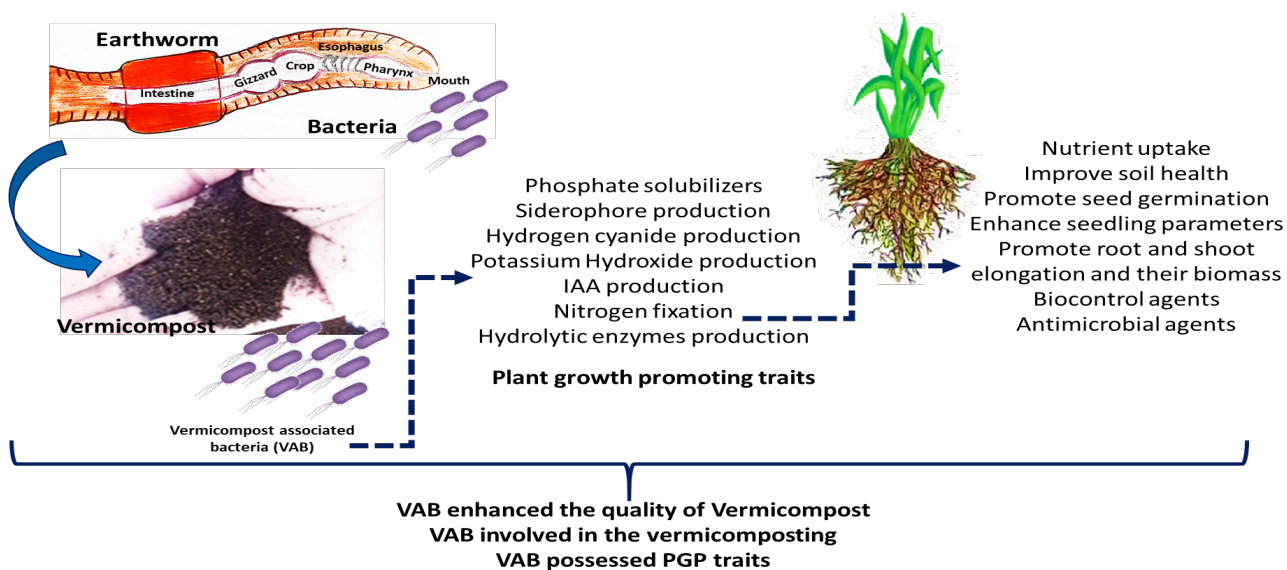
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Supplementary Fig. 1. Production and importance of vermicompost associated bacteria as plant growth promoting bacteria.

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
