Feasibility of enrichment of compost for nitrogen content and improvement of Bio-Geyser (2012-2018)

Feasibility studies on enrichment of compost for nitrogen content are in progress to identify suitable agro-wastes. Protocol for preparation of compost tea from compost is in the process of standardization. Evaluation of compost and compost tea along with inorganic fertilizers for improving yield of vegetables is carried out under field conditions. Heat generated naturally during composting of residues is being used sustainably by developing Bio-Geyser technology for heating water. Efforts are in progress to further improve design and efficiency of Bio-Geyser. Extension services are a regular feature of our group to popularize dual technology of compost and Bio-Geyser so that end-users can learn and adopt the technology. Twenty five (25) bio-geysers have been fabricated and demonstrated at community level in Hazara Division and Swat district under a grant from Pakistan Science Foundation and Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency, Islamabad, Pakistan. A one day training workshop on dual technology was organized for end-users in the districts of Mansehra and Swat.

Water relations of lucerne under organic farming conditions (2007-2011) - Ph.D. thesis

Experimental and modeling approaches were used to identify lucerne genotypes and utilization systems for enhancing water use efficiency and crop productivity under semi-arid conditions in eastern Austria. Water balance approach was used to quantify water use efficiency. Core method of root sampling was used to collect roots for assessing the differences among genotypes. Root traits were studied using WinRhizo software for further use as data input to the simulation model making the study innovative as measured data on root traits is rarely used in the simulations of water uptake.

Simulation model, CropSyst was applied to analyze the impact of plant traits and management interventions on components of water balance and hypothesize an ideotype for water limited conditions in Austria. Field experiments were also conducted to study effect of mulching with lucerne on yield, water use efficiency and biological nitrogen fixation. ¹⁵N isotopic dilution method was used to assess nitrogen fixation. Inter disciplinary research was carried out in the project involving agronomy, soil chemistry, soil physics, mass spectrometry, meteorology and root morphology.

Data was analyzed using SPSS and published (3 articles in peer reviewed journals and 1 book chapter) besides presenting 4 abstracts/posters in conferences.

Transfer of disease resistance in bread wheat (2011-2012, 2001-2006)

Extensive screening of germplasm (local and exotic from collaborators viz. ICARDA, CIMMYT, etc.) was carried out for biotic (leaf rust and stem rust) and abiotic stresses (water and heat) under field and glass house conditions to identify suitable parents for development of high yielding and rust tolerant wheat varieties. Advance lines were tested in a series of on farm yield trials before testing the material at farmer's field. A package of production technology was

developed for promising entries before their release as variety at national level. Project released three varieties as a result of team work. Higher standards of seed purity were achieved by raising single spike and single row progenies.

Data was published in national journals and presented at conferences. Promotion of ongoing research activities was carried out by organizing farmers days and field days.

Farm management (2001-2006)

An experimental farm of 65 hectares was efficiently managed for multi-purpose activities of field experimentation, seed production, orchard management and income generation using available resources. Improved lay out of farm lands for enhancing water use efficiency and reclamation of saline lands were the key interventions introduced. Special focus was given to streamline the strategy for wheat seed production under the guideline of federal seed certification department and higher purity was assured by adopting technical guidelines right from sowing till processing and marketing.

Administrative assignments included supervision of farm staff (100 members), record keeping as per farm procedures of the organization, preparation of farm budgets and periodical reports on farm activities, procurement of farm related inputs and machinery and assistance in organizing field /farmers days and training workshops on regular basis.

Farmers participatory saline agriculture development project (2002)

Assisted in preliminary surveys for site selection and soil sampling before introducing suitable interventions on saline lands for their economic utilization and provided technical support for raising nursery of salt tolerant tree species and transplantation to field sites. Worked as a team member to set up an office at project site for smooth functioning of project activities.
