Getting personal with mathematics

Now by Profession I am a chemist, but I relish *Mathematics*. I comprehend the Mathematics as a real science...other sciences are also real, every branch has its own unmatched significant space, but in the sense that, universe is written in mathematics, nature talks mathematics. Now scientifically speaking that implies to the digit 0, 0 is the digit that is complete in itself, it is the only digit from which it is subtracted, its completeness remains that is why I called it, “*God’s digit.*”

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The concept of nothingness, emptiness, vacuum are the physical significance of digit ‘0’ or can be mathematically written as 0 i.e. $A+0=A$. On religious grounds, the great *Albert Einstein* was highly impressed by *Buddhism*. Buddhism talks about “*Sunyata*” concept (Sanskrit noun from the adj. *sunya or shunya: "zero, nothing"*) is usually translated as "emptiness". .
